RESHAPING AND STRENGTHENING OUR MENTAL HEALTH SYSTEM

The need for a connected mental health and addictions system in our community has never been greater – there is growing recognition that our current mental health system is inadequate and inequitable, with too many people falling through the cracks. Alectra's generous investment of \$1.05 million will help create new models of care that are equitable and meet the needs of our community members, with a focus on prevention, early detection, access and effective patient-centred treatment.

Your visionary funding has catalyzed this groundbreaking work, enabling mental health system improvement through advances in clinical and research programs. This includes conducting research in the key areas of population health, Learning Health Systems (LHS), integrated care, patient and family-centred care, implementation and evaluation science, all in collaboration with other members of the IBH team, the hospital's Mental Health Program and community partners.

We are thrilled to share that after an extensive international search, Dr. Deborah Scharf has joined THP as a Senior Clinician Scientist in Mental Health and Addictions. Our search was thorough and meticulous, as we sought a candidate with

the right blend of scientific expertise and clinical experience. Dr. Scharf's impressive credentials and comprehensive background in mental health and addictions make her the ideal leader for this pivotal role.

Dr. Scharf will serve in dual capacities within the Mental Health Program: clinically, she will work closely with the eating disorders team; and as Senior Scientist, she will collaborate with various clinical teams and IBH in the ongoing redesign of the mental health system. Her collaborative spirit and unwavering commitment to addressing healthcare inequities make her an invaluable addition to our team, propelling us toward a future where access to care is improved and outcomes are better for all.

Dr. Scharf is a highly respected clinical and health psychologist, registered with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. Prior to joing IBH, she was a tentured Associate Professor of Psychology at Lakehead University, where she also served as an Adjunct Professor of Health Sciences and Mental Health



Lead at the Enhancing the Prevention of Injury and Disability at Work Institute. Before that, she was a Full Behavioural Scientist at the worldrenowned RAND Corporation where her research directly informed models of care specified in the Affordable Care Act. In addition to her academic and leadership roles, Dr. Scharf maintains a small private practice, providing evidence-based clinical interventions to individual adults and couples.

Her research is at the forefront of improving mental health and addiction care delivery systems, focusing on innovations in clinical quality measurement, training, service delivery, healthcare financing, and policy. Dr. Scharf's work includes pioneering studies in integrated care for underserved populations, including adults with serious mental illness, cancer, and comorbidities, substance use treatment models and policy as well as research aimed at improving care systems for injured workers and veterans.

Dr. Scharf holds both a Doctor of Philosophy and Master of Science in Clinical Psychology and Biological and Health Psychology from the University of Pittsburgh, and an Honours Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from McGill University.
